This Show is a qualifier for the 2019 BSPS Championship Show to be held at Arena UK.

Hat Rules

When jumping in the Ring, the practice or collecting areas, all Riders must wear protective headgear, according to the current standards as listed below:

All PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards;

Skullcaps must be of, or worn with, a dark coloured plain peaked cover. Refer to your Society/Association Rule Book for further clarification.

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders between the ages of 15 to 17 inclusive.

All PAS 015; VG1; (BS) EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.

The most recent updates to the list are the addition of SNELL E2016 and EN1384 (2017); the newest version of the SNELL Standard could have begun to appear in 2017 and is accepted to the list; the newest version of the EN1384 Standard will begin to appear during 2018 and is also accepted to the list.

Class 1 Novice Cob

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms, that has not won a 1st prize of £35 or more or a total of £250. Snaffle bridles may be worn for Novice classes.

Class 2 Amateur Cob

Open to horses owned and ridden by an amateur (BSHA rule 7 A – C). Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm.

Class 3 Lightweight Cob

Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 155cm and capable of carrying up to 14 stone

Class 4 Heavyweight Cob

Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 155cm and capable of carrying more than 14 stone.

Class 5 Maxi Cob

Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 155cm. Judges must pay particular attention to type (i.e. short legged animals of cob type). To be shown hogged.



Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms. Suitable and to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 107 BSPS Show Hunter Pony, 143cms

Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Suitable and to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 108 BSPS Show Hunter Pony, 153cms

Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms. Suitable and to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard (in the current season or previous season).

Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season.

Horses and riders must not have received any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current or previous season.

Horses must not have been ridden at a show by a rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season.

Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 3yrs and over, fillies, mares and geldings.

Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored.

Class 111 Side Saddle Concours d'Elegance

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult Member and Junior Member of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards. Competitors must wear a hat to current Safety Standard or above.

Class 112 Side Saddle Costume Concours d'Elegance

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse/pony and rider, and the way of going of the horse/pony. Safe tack must be used. Detailed inspection of the rider's period costume is not required. Fancy dress is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the judge may ask small groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Member of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Card. Competitors should produce a brief résumé about their costumes for the Commentator. Competitors must wear a hat to current Safety Standard or above.

Class 113 Side Saddle Riding Club Horse or Pony

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over. Riders will be required to give a short show including a small jump, maximum 61cm (2'). The height may be adjusted during the course of the class at the Judge's discretion. The class shall be judged on the show, the manners of horse/pony and its suitability for the rider. Conformation will not be considered. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards. Competitors must wear a hat to current Safety Standard or above.

Classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs.

Part Bred classes, are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". The exhibit must have one parent that is traditional gypsy cob, a minimum of 50% breeding is accepted.

Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST have be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook.

Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members will receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

Championship Shows

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship, provided they are current TGCA members and the horse is TGCA registered. Membership cards and qualification cards (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS. Part Breds go forward to the Go for Glory Championship, for 2019 qualifiers there is no requirement for membership or registration

(apart from stallions) on the date of the show. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Crowning Glory Championships at TOYS
